

GPE LOCATION PROFILES

CHINA

The GPE in China typically takes place in either Beijing or Hangzhou, although locations may vary. All students will begin the GPE program with a one-week orientation at the Notre Dame Beijing Global Gateway before departing for their placement site. While placements sites in China are subject to availability, past GPE organizations have included Caixin Media, Xiaomi, Inc., and Topsun. Chinese language proficiency is not required for all sites; however, some organizations seek students who are fluent or proficient in Mandarin Chinese. A good student fit would include those who are studying economics, political science, business management, marketing, industrial design, and social sciences.

Visas are required for all non-Chinese citizens to participate in the GPE program in China. The cost of a Chinese visa is not included in the program fee, so students can expect an additional fee of \$140.

HONG KONG

The GPE in Hong Kong program will begin with a one-week orientation at the Notre Dame Hong Kong Global Center. While placements sites in Hong Kong are subject to availability, past GPE organizations have included Esquel Group, Citigroup, and Teach Unlimited. The experience will be conducted entirely in English and knowledge of a second language is not required. A good student fit would include those who are studying or interested in business and manufacturing, youth education, social work, or banking and finance.

Visas are required in order to participate in the GPE program in Hong Kong. The cost of a Hong Kong visa is not included in the program fee, so students can expect an additional fee of up to \$50.

INDIA

The GPE in India typically takes place in either New Delhi or Pune, although locations may vary. All students will begin the GPE program with a one-week orientation hosted by the Notre Dame Mumbai Global Center before departing for their placement site. While placements sites in India are subject to availability, past GPE organizations have included the UN Global Compact Network India and Cummins India Ltd. The experience will be conducted entirely in English and knowledge of a second language is not required. A good student fit would include those who are studying political science, environmental sciences, or social sciences, but the opportunities in India are not limited to students from a specific field of study.

Visas are required for all non-Indian citizens to participate in the GPE program in India. The cost of a visa is not included in the program fee, so students can expect an additional fee of up to approximately \$100.

BRAZIL

The GPE in Brazil takes place in the country's biggest city, São Paulo. In this program, students are typically placed in positions in the areas of eCommerce analytics, fintech, education management, non-profit, and real estate management. Students stay in host families and will count with the support of Notre Dame's São Paulo Global Center. A good student fit would include those either majoring or interested in business, economics, ESS, or Brazilian students. Portuguese or Spanish would be an asset for some positions, but not required. Most positions will be fully operated in English.

CHILE

The GPE in Chile takes place in the country's capital, Santiago. In this program, students are typically placed in positions in the areas of law, engineering, business and non-profit. Students stay in host families and will count with the support of Notre Dame's Santiago Global Center. A good student fit would include those either majoring or interested in law, business, political science, or Spanish. For some positions, particularly in law, students with Spanish knowledge will take priority.



MEXICO

The GPE in Mexico takes place in Mexico City or in Puebla, depending on the position. For students interested in the medical-track GPE, we offer positions in Puebla, allowing students to engage in a series of trips, workshops, and supervised medical shadowing. For students interested in the business or non-profit track, positions in Mexico City and Puebla may include experiences working with municipal governments, immigration policy, marketing, or finance. For medical positions, some knowledge of Spanish will be required and evaluated on a case-by-case basis. For other tracks, Spanish is an asset but not a requirement. Students in either location will count with the support of Notre Dame's Mexico City Global Center as well as the support of Lisette Monterroso, on-site director for Notre Dame operations in Puebla.

ENGLAND

The GPE in England takes place in London. The London Global Gateway partners with a variety of organizations including businesses (large corporates and start-ups), non-profits, healthcare providers and Catholic schools. While placements sites in London are subject to availability, past GPE organizations have included the Cleveland Clinic, C3 Collaborating for Health and British Expertise. A good student fit for these placements include those who are studying or are interested in management, health care, including the business side of medicine, event planning and secondary school education; however, opportunities in England are not limited to a particular field of study. All students will have a one week GPE orientation at the London Global Gateway before departing for their placement site. Students will live in Conway Hall, Notre Dame's Global Gateway student residence.

Visas are required for all non-European citizens to participate in the GPE program in England. The cost of a Tier 5 visa is not included in the program fee. The cost is £240 (\$315 approx.) for the visa itself (plus additional shipping) + \$775 to BUNAC for their sponsorship.

GREECE

The GPE in Greece takes place in Athens, where we partner with the College Year in Athens (CYA) to give students placements in cutting-edge non-profit organizations doing nationally-recognized work with refugees. Students in the past have performed a range of tasks from organizing and streamlining the social media and digital marketing presence of these organizations, all the way to visiting on-site locations and talking to staff. A good student fit would include those either majoring or interested in international development, topics in economics and migration, and political science. This experience is conducted entirely in English and no knowledge of modern Greek is required. Typically, we take anywhere from 4-6 students for this location, and no visa is required.
